There is no supervision on campus before 7:25am. Please do not allow your son or daughter to be on campus before 7:25am.

Drop off / Pick up

- ☞ All students will be dropped off in front of the school.
- ☞ The parking lot is divided into two lanes.
- ☞ The lane closest to the building (right) please pull all the way forward to drop off & pick-up students.
- ☞ The lane closest to the parking lot (left) is a pull thru lane. Only use this lane if you plan on parking and walking your child across the crosswalk.

Walkers

- ☞ All walkers must enter the campus through the front gate (located next to the front office) or back gate.

Bicycle Riders

- ☞ Please always walk your bikes, scooters, and skateboards while on campus. All bikes and scooters must be locked to a bike rack.

Front Office

Uniforms

Backpacks for Grades 6-8 are allowed.

Uniform for Boys/Girls

- ☺ Solid dark green, solid ash gray, or solid burgundy shirts with lay-down collar. This may include, but is not limited to, a “polo” shirt and dress shirt. No logos or labels showing on the shirt.
- ☺ Solid navy blue or khaki shorts/slacks. No logos, labels, blue jeans, blue-jean shorts, sweat pants, or stretchy type material.
- ☺ White, blue or black leggings may be worn.

General Guideline for All Students

- ✓ Shirts and blouses must be worn **tucked in** at all times.
- ✓ Shorts must not be shorter than the middle of the thigh or longer than the bottom of the knee.
- ✓ Belts must be plain black, brown, or navy and may not be more than one (1) size larger than the waist. Belts must be worn at the waist and cannot hang below the waist. Belts and buckles must be plain with no designs or logos.
- ✓ For safety reasons, students must wear closed toed shoes. Slippers and shoes with wheels are not permitted.
- ✓ Jackets may be worn outside, but removed inside building.
- ✓ Sweatshirts/sweaters may be worn inside, but **MUST** be district approved dress code colors. Hoods are not to be worn in building. No Logos
