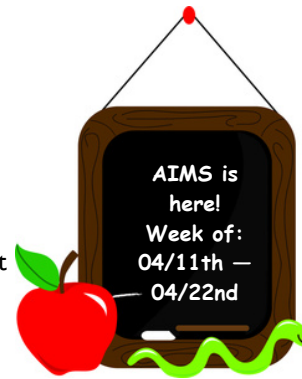

AIMS Testing is here!

The Littleton Elementary School leadership team, teachers and staff would like to remind you that AIMS testing begins on April 11th - April 22nd.

During the dates of April 11 through April 15th, students in grades 2nd through 8th will be tested using either the Stanford 10 Assessment or the AIMS-DPA assessment. Make up testing will also occur the week of April 18th as needed. We are asking for your help in supporting your child's efforts to perform at his/her best during testing. The following are some suggestions on how you can help your child be successful:

- Attendance – Ensure that your child is at school and on time during the testing sessions. (i.e.: Do not plan any appointments on test dates).
- Rest – Ensure that your child is well rested (i.e.: Gets to bed early).
- Nutrition – Ensure that your child eats breakfast (Breakfast is served in the classroom beginning at 7:20 a.m.)
- Support – Discuss the importance of testing. Encourage your child to listen carefully to all test-taking directions given by the teacher and to ask questions about any directions that are unclear.
- Positive Environment – Maintain a pleasant home environment (i.e: Avoid any unnecessary conflicts).
- Encouragement - Encourage your child to do his/her best (i.e.: Wish your child good luck before he or she leaves for school)
