A Message From Our Principal...

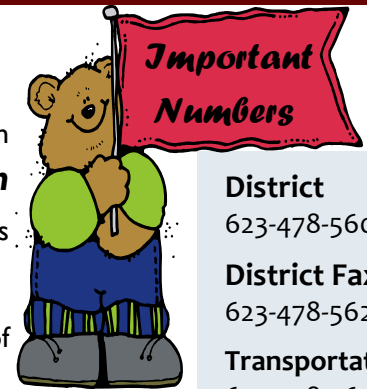
Dear Littleton Elementary Families,

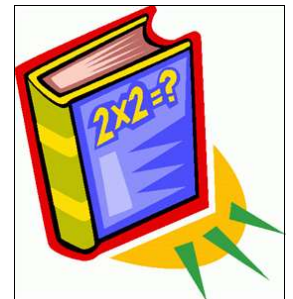
