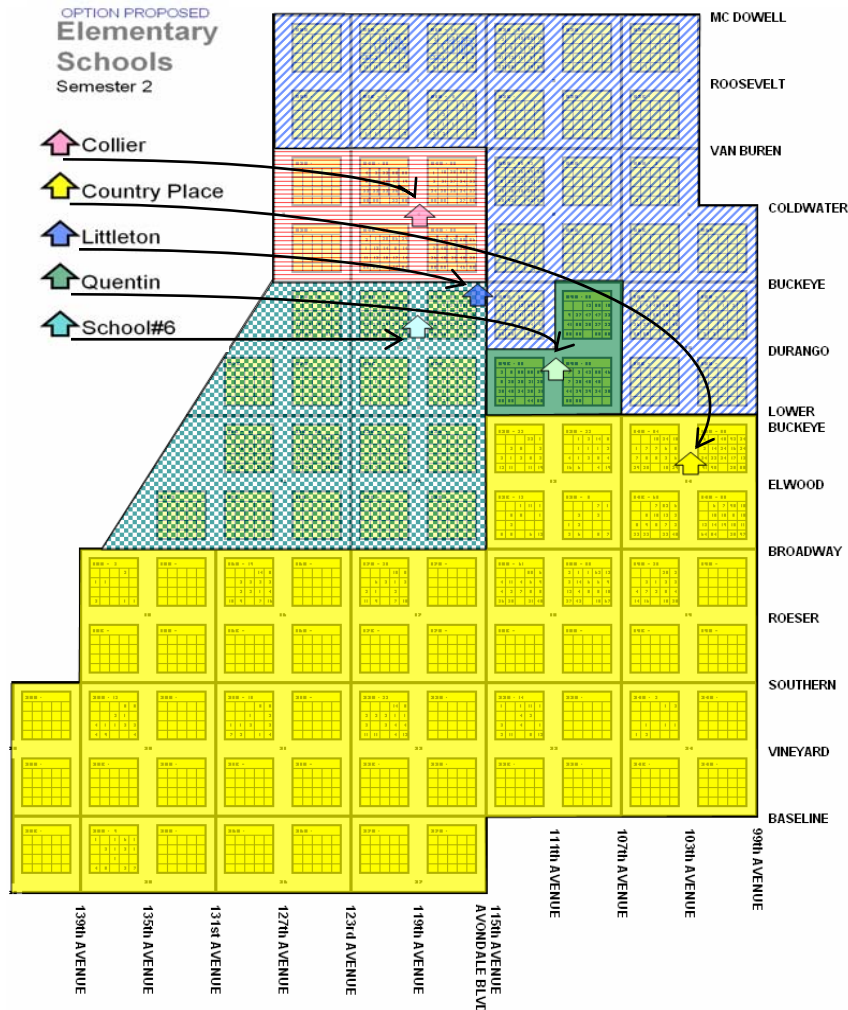

TITLE: 2007-08 School Attendance Boundaries

Attendance Area Descriptive Changes and Graphics

- Collier ES remains K-8 and the attendance area does not change: the areas between Van Buren to Buckeye Roads and between Avondale Boulevard to the Agua Fria River.
- Country Place ES remains K-8, but will no longer include the square mile of area between Buckeye to Lower Buckeye Roads and between El Mirage Road to the Agua Fria River. All areas South of Lower Buckeye and East of 115th Avenue as well as all areas south of Broadway and West of 115th Avenue will continue to attend Country Place.
- Littleton ES remains K-6 and the attendance area adds the square mile between Buckeye to Lower Buckeye Roads and between 99th to 107th Avenues, but is reduced to no longer include any areas south of Buckeye Road and West of Avondale Boulevard.
- Quentin ES becomes K-8 and the attendance area is reduced to no longer include the square mile between Buckeye to Lower Buckeye Roads and between 99th to 107th Avenues.
- School #6 ES will start as a K-6 and the attendance area is between Buckeye to Broadway Roads and between Avondale Boulevard to the Agua Fria River.

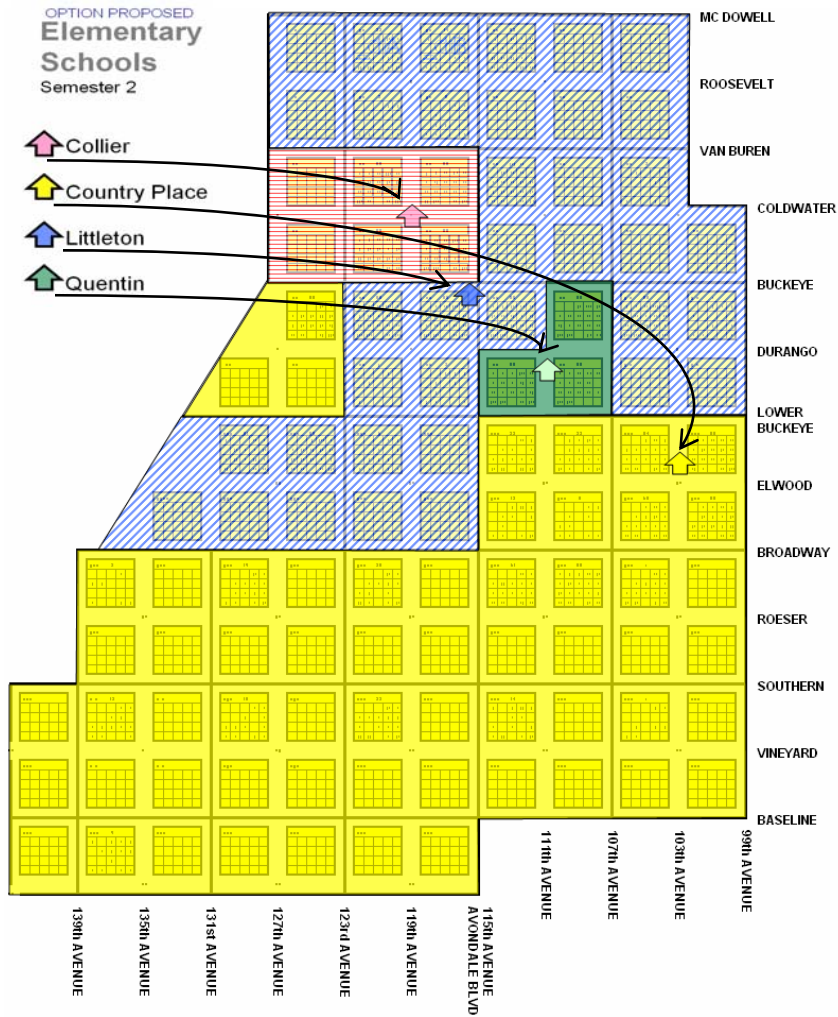

- Underdown JHS remains 7-8 and the attendance area adds the square mile between Buckeye to Lower Buckeye Roads and between El Mirage Road to the Agua Fria River, but it is reduced by no longer including any areas between Buckeye to Lower Buckeye Roads and between 107th to 111th Avenues as well as the areas between Durango to Lower Buckeye Roads and between 111th to 115th Avenues.
