How to Prepare for Parent-Teacher Conferences

Conferences are coming up from Wed. 5th – Fri. 7th. They will be conducted by the classroom teacher with early dismissal at 1:20 each day. You'll receive reports from DIBELS for reading, math assessments, along with the most vital information on your child's progress. The most important traits for success are:

- Come to school daily and on time. *Venir a la escuela todos los días y llegar a tiempo.*
 - Complete home work assignments. *Hacer la tarea*
 - Do class work. *Hacer el trabajo del salón.*
 - Memorize multiplication tables. *Memorizarse las tablas de multiplicación.*

Please ask your child how he/she is doing in these areas. Report cards should never be a surprise. *Preguntele a su hijo(a) como va en estas areas. Las boletas no deberian ser una sorpresa.*
