At the May 2026 Governing Board Meeting, the Littleton ESD Governing Board approved the District to go out for a Bond Election for the Nov. 3, 2026 Election. 2026 BOND FACTS

ELECTION DAY
NOV. 3
2026

The Governing Board of the District passed and adopted a resolution calling a bond election to authorize the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$95,000,000. This election is being held to provide funds to replace, repair and renovate facilities. The bond election will also support purchasing of pupil transportation, furniture, technology and other materials for instructional purposes.

The average tax rate for the proposed bond authorization is \$0.69 per \$100 of net assessed limited property value.

Why is the District holding the Bond Election?

The measure would provide funding for facility construction, acquisition, renovations, and site improvements, as well as pupil transportation vehicles, furniture, equipment, and instructional technology. Current state and formula-based capital funding is limited, with additional support for major renovations, new construction, and replacement buildings generally available only under specific conditions.

What happens if the Bond does not pass?

Without additional Bond funding, the District may be unable to address aging facilities, expand capacity for future growth, or complete important campus and infrastructure improvements. Some projects may need to be postponed, reduced in scope, or reconsidered in future planning efforts.

HAVE YOU PURCHASED LAPTOP PROTECTION?

The Littleton ESD Technology Department is again providing laptop protection for students at a low cost of \$29. This cost covers accidental damage of your child's laptop for the entire school year and serves as a great peace of mind for not having to pay for accidents when they do happen. A cracked screen will cost \$150 if you do not have the protection plan.

Next Friday, Aug. 21 is the last day to purchase a plan without having the device inspected. So don't wait for an accident to happen. Purchase the plan today!

Service will be requested within 1 business day of when purchase. Service with prior damage not already paid for will not be eligible for service. Purchase plan only at the end of the school year.

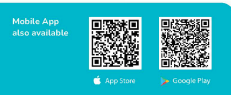
